
Education, Anticipation plus Ability Saves Lives

After a year of close brothers and sisters having incidents on two wheels, some minor and some major, I feel compelled to readdress an article that I had addressed back in July. I know that pride sometimes gets in our way of growth. Someone casually suggests taking a riding class and the knee jerk reaction is “I know how to ride I have been riding xxx years”. No one is questioning your riding ability they are just showing their concern and love for you. You read a book or google a subject to understand more about that subject and to better yourself. This same approach should also be done diligently by anyone on a motorcycle. Take courses from certified instructors and learn from them things that you do not normally encounter and put those new found skills to use. We all love to ride and we all love to live, with that in mind we have to realize that we are ultimately responsible for our own safety. We do this by education, ability and anticipation. We educate not only ourselves about motorcycling but we also educate others that may not ride motorcycles about noticing and driving safely around motorcycles. The real meat and potatoes of riding safely is anticipation and ability.

We always need to be realizing what is going on around us. We must always anticipate what others are doing, fixing to do, or could possibly do so that we will be ready to react in a manner to literally save our and our passengers lives. Always anticipate that they are fixing to do something stupid in your path and your percentages of making contact with them will be greatly reduced. We also need to realize our individual ability on these machines. Everyone does not have the same ability to handle a motorcycle so you must always ride within your ability. Until you have practiced successfully your sudden stops, quick turns, and most important, your swerves be sure to maintain slower speeds (possibly below the posted speed limit) and longer following distances. You do not have to keep up with others to enjoy riding so always stay within your ability this will also increase your percentages of making it home safe and/or alive.

Always remember Capt. K loves all of his brothers and sisters and I am a little bit selfish in that I want all of them to be safe and alive so that I can enjoy their company when I get the opportunity. We really need your help to make Gaston County MSAP the success that it can be. Not only does it make our riding experience safer but it provides CBA clout with our representatives by providing the numbers of potential drivers that are reached through our safety program. I am available to provide support and training to anyone that would like to participate in making our roads a safer place to ride. We are in need of MSAP instructors to help make our riding experiences safer by donating a little bit of time to educate drivers (experienced and potential) about being aware of everything around them. 



Master Sergeant at Arms–

MSAP–Robert discussed counter-steering for curves and classes/courses for experienced riders so that they continue to add “tools” to their “toolboxes” to continue honing and improving knowledge and skills as riders.

- We voted on two proposals from the CBA state meeting that was held in October. *Proposal one:* Article II “The Board of Directors” #4, section A, #3 (62.5% of the member vote was in favor of this proposal and 37.5% voted against this proposal – the chapters 5 votes will be split 3-2 at the state meeting in January to accurately reflect the member voting). *Proposal two:* Article II “The Board of Directors” #4, section B (100% of the member vote was in favor of this proposal – the chapters 5 votes will be in favor of this proposal at the state meeting in January).

- Pete McGinnis was nominated for Treasurer at the November Officer's Meeting (no one else was nominated) – Pete will continue as the Treasurer for 2016.

- Dale Carroll was nominated for Legislative Coordinator at the November Officer's Meeting (no one else was nominated) – Dale will become the new Legislative Coordinator in January for 2016.

Membership contest – Buncombe county CBA has contributed \$500 for the contest. The contest will run from January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016. The member who recruits the most new members and can get members to rejoin who have been lapsed for at least one year will win \$250. For every 10 members that sign up, your name goes into a drawing for another \$250. There is a place on the membership applications for the recruiter to place their name.


