

If you never attend a meeting or help with an event, your membership is important. Of course we would like for you to attend the meetings and help with events but it isn't a requirement. Please go online now on our website (see address above) to join/rejoin/renew your membership or fill out the application in this newsletter and help us protect your rights. If you are a member, give the application to a friend. We are constantly working on issues such as anti-discrimination, anti-profiling, access for motorcycles to public facilities and freedom of choice (helmet). On the last issue of my list, SC ABATE is having a Helmet Law Support Ride on October 1st. It seems they have some legislators down there that want a helmet law. If you are able to go—please do so. I've included their flyer in this issue. Most of us enjoy riding in SC without a helmet, so if you want to continue doing it—give them your support. Plus it's not that far and would be a good ride for the day.

Angela touches on a subject that all or most of us have difficulty with. To support or not to support club and organization rides/events. We have bikers that won't belong to CBA because they feel like they "have to" support all the rides in our area. Well I'm here to tell you—you don't! Sometimes I feel like I'm preaching to an empty "church" but more often lately you are getting the message that the CBA & MRF is important in the lives of bikers.
