It's different than some of the others. Hundreds of children wait in line behind the U Haul trucks loaded with toys. And when they open the back of those trucks to give out the toys, you will get to see the smiles light up on the children's faces. Santa & Mrs. Claus will be there to greet the children along with some of his reindeer and a lot of Santa's helpers. Bikers from everywhere shine their bikes up to ride on this very special day and to see those smiles make all the year long effort worth it!

The money raised during the year (100%) goes directly to the purchase of toys for the kids in our community. The Gastonia Police Department and the Gaston County Sheriff's Department escorted ride will have a different route this year. Still starts at the Ranlo Church of God but Cramer Middle School and Catawba Heights Baptist Church are not open due to Covid-19. The run will end at Parkwood Baptist Church on Garrison Blvd., Gastonia. The kind folks there will feed us and that's where the 2005 Harley Davidson 1200 Sportster bike will be raffled off. Tickets are 25 for \$20 (you can purchase smaller amounts) available for purchase on the day of the run on Saturday, December 5th. A special THANK YOU to all the participants who have kept this toy run going for 25 years!

One last thing that's on my mind before I go...thinking of this time of year...it's deer season. They run in packs, so if you see one getting ready to cross the road, there's usually one or more behind.
